In the case of a degree obtained abroad, the evaluation of the requirement will be carried out by the selection committee.

Additional access requirements:

International students are required to have a qualification equivalent to B2 for the Italian Language

Type of estimable qualifications

Qualification assessments (up to 60 marks):

- up to maximum 26 marks for the assessment of the scientific and professional course (as shown in the curriculum vitae and any attachments);
- up to maximum 25 marks for a submitted research project;
- up to maximum 3 marks for the contents of any presentation letters submitted by the
- candidate;
- up to maximum 6 marks for other qualifications connected to contracts, scholarships and assignments served in national, foreign or international research institutions, duly certificated showing the activity's effective date and duration.

Interview (up to 30 marks):

- knowledge of the English language and, for foreign students, also of the Italian language: up to 5 points
- discussion of the research project (assessment of the candidate's capacity to convincingly discuss project preconditions and goals): up to 15 marks;
