- up to maximum 6 marks for other qualifications connected to served contracts, scholarships and assignments in national, foreign or international research bodies, duly certificated, showing the activity's effective date and duration;

Interview (up to 30 marks):

- Illustration of the submitted research project contents and goals (up to 10 marks);
- Project and own formative and working experiences in connection with research orientation and paths of the doctoral School, especially if related to the subjects listed below (up to 15 marks):
 - labour and labour economics rights;
 - pedagogy of education and the person;
 - clinical psychology;
 - anthropology, sociology and geography;
- Mastery of the English language (up to 5 marks).
