The objective of the project is to provide a reconstruction and an interpretative analysis of the economic and social history of Bergamo and its territory from the medieval age to the contemporary age. The structural changes, the discontinuities, the social movements as well as the paths of companies and entrepreneurs that have characterized and made the Bergamo area famous will be examined against the background of the evolution of the world economic context: this will constitute the fundamental element to bring out fully and discuss the possible patterns of growth, continuity and change of the local economy, retracing its genealogy of the present. The research project also aims to develop and implement innovative tools in the dissemination of research results both in a third mission and didactic logic, in collaboration with the archival organizations present in the province of Bergamo.
