Inhabitants of Contrada and roads of connection: community activation projects and experiments to look to a possible future in Valtellina

The project proposal is part of a more complex survey entitled "The Roots of an Identity. Themes, tools and itineraries for the (re) discovery of Sondrio's area between prehistory and the Middle Ages" shared and proposed by the Mountain Community Valtellina di Sondrio (leader of the project) in the context of the "Bandi Emblematici Maggiori" of the CARIPLO Foundation. The research will explore the following themes: the re-signification of identity and cultural fruition, the circulation of knowledge and social inclusion, the construction of synergies with production contexts and subjects with knowledge / competence, the definition of common strategies between public and private, together with the promotion of educational and educational processes, in the area of the municipalities of the Valtellina involved. The University of Bergamo participates in some actions of the project, one of its units of analysis will be interested in the operational development of the action n.6 "Inhabitants of Contrada and routes of connection: Scilironi community activation projects and experiments to look at a possible future ". It will be necessary to elaborate a socio-economic analysis of the area of interest and, at the same time, to identify the subjects through which to bring out the latent variables that are behind the memory of the place. Field research will make use of qualitative methodologies, in particular in-depth interviews. About 30 interviews will be carried out. On the one hand, privileged witnesses will be interviewed to deepen their knowledge of the social reality of reference. On the other hand, the inhabitants and former inhabitants of the village of Scilironi, Polaggia e Melliolo will be interviewed. Afterwards, the empirical materials collected will be analyzed and the results will be presented in academic conferences and scientific publications.
