## **Objectives**

Research on the phenomena of business creation is shifting towards the interdisciplinary study of the different forms and different contexts of entrepreneurship. The project aims to contribute to the development of research in the University Entrepreneurship, i.e. the study of the companies founded by students and researchers (academic spin-off). It is a field that still lacks theoretical tools explaining many of the conflicting empirical findings (i.e., how and why the university context influences the chances of survival of the enterprise). The project aims to borrow recent theoretical perspectives from the field of Embedded Entrepreneurship applying them to the field of University Entrepreneurship.

## Research project

In order to explain various controversial aspects associated with firm performance.
