Research object

The research will be focused on the latest developments of the labour market discipline and in particular on the active policies at European, Italian and regional level. The analyses requested will reflect on the cultural, epistemological, pedagogical and sociological underlying aspects through the study of the structure of some European labour market organization models, the tools of active policy used by them in support of employment and their dynamics of involvement of public and private operators. The construction of an interdisciplinary theoretical framework will aim to conduct a more thorough investigation and analysis of the Lombard Dote Unica Lavoro model. Then, there will be highlighted the strengths, constraints and opportunities for the development and evolution of this model, also to guide and orient operators, whether public or private, in carrying out their active policies activities

Research structure

Research in all its phases will take place on the two levels of the literature research and the critical analysis and it will be developed in three steps.

The first one will require an interdisciplinary study on the issues related to the organization of the labour market, the active policies and the relationship between public and private stakeholders at both European and national level.

After creating a theoretical frame of reference, the research will continue with a second phase of study on the dynamics related to the implementation of active policies in Lombardy Region. It will be assumed as focus of the analysis the Dote Unica Lavoro system and its particular characteristics in relation to its evolutions and to the various territorial, economic, political and cultural contexts in which it is insert.

In a third step, thanks to knowledge and critical reflections acquired previously, the research will continue with the identification of the most recent developments of the model, also in view of further future projects aimed at contributing to the construction of an organizational model for the services provided by DUL (Youth Guarantee included), useful to accredited operators working in the field.
