Contenuti e obiettivi formativi	The workshop activities concern one of the main educational goals of the MA in Planning and Management of Tourism Systems (PMTS), that is, to provide "advanced skills in the promotion and management of tourism products, especially by the means of the new multimedia technologies". Students will be provided with basic technical skills and methodological tools useful for creating GIS digital cartographic systems and for using GeoWeb 2.0 cartographic systems for the promotion and communication of geographical information in the tourism sector. Secondary target students can be the ones attending the Master courses <i>in Lingue Moderne per la Cooperazione e la Cooperazione Internazionale</i> .
Articolazione del laboratorio	The workshop will require an approximate total amount of 125 hours work, subdivided as follows: - 40 hours of guided work: ∞ a first theoretical part on how GISs work (10 hours); ∞ practical activity in order to learn how to produce automatic cartography and map-based touristic information in the web (20 hours); ∞ verification of the acquired skills (10 hours); - 85 hours of autonomous work: Each student will be expected to submit a paper demonstrating the acquisition of specific skills applied to the analysis of a topic of his/her choice. Practical activities will be held at the <i>Diathesis Cartographic Lab</i> (Room 50, Salvecchio). Different working groups will be formed

	based on the selected topics, which could deal with various aspects related to tourism and territorial and environmental planning.
