



## **Calls for Short or Long term incoming Visiting Professors/Researchers: main information**

### **Required activities:**

- research activity in collaboration with the inviting Professor at the University of Bergamo (UniBg)
- at least one seminar (short term) or two seminars (long term) to be held at UniBg
- submission of a report on the research activities carried out at UniBg, at the end of the mobility period.

### **Applications and deadlines:**

The application can be submitted only by the inviting Professor at UniBg.

The deadline for applications is 30th September 2024, both for the Short term and the Long Term Incoming Visiting Professors/Researchers Calls.

### **Results:**

Selection results will be available by the end of November 2024.

### **Grant:**

The grant is a lump sum amount covering all costs.

Please be aware that **the grant is subject to taxes**, according to the current legislation, and therefore **the effective amount the Professor/Researcher is going to receive is lower than the total awarded amount**.

For **short term** visiting, the grant amounts to 1,885 € gross for a 15 days mobility period, and to 3,780 € gross for a 30 days visiting period.

From the 16th to the 29th day, a daily grant of 126 € gross is added.

The grant will be transferred at the end of the mobility period, after the submission of the activities report (in Italian or English).

For **long term** visiting, the grant amounts to 3,900 € gross for a 31 days mobility period, and to 7,560 € gross for a 60 days visiting period.

From the 32nd to the 59th day, a daily grant of 126 € gross is added.

The grant will be transferred at the end of the mobility period, after the submission of the activities report (in Italian or English).

### **Mobility conditions.**

The mobility period is intended as consecutive.

For short term visiting periods, the minimum stay is 15 days, and the maximum stay is 30 days.

For long term visiting periods, the minimum stay is 31 days, and the maximum stay is 60 days.
