OBJECTIVES OF THE MEETING

In line with the overall scope of the TNE UNITAFRICA project to foster cooperation between Italian and African Universities through innovative teaching methods and training opportunities, the Addis Ababa first physical consortium-wide meeting represents a milestone to strengthen the interaction between the Italian and African Partners in the perspective of ensuring a solid project implementation according to its aims and structure.
